



# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Congratulations, you have purchased the finest air filter that money can buy. With proper care, this filter will last 1 million miles or more. This filter can be used in a stock machine, with no modifications required. If any engine modifications have been made tuning/jetting adjustments may be required. There are special installation instructions, so please follow the procedures outlined below to ensure the K&N® Filtercharger® seals properly.

### INSTALLATION:

1. Remove the OE filter from airbox by removing the 4 screws retaining the airbox lid. (Fig. 1 & 2)

**NOTE: remove any dirt and debris that may be present in the filter housing.**

2. Remove the 2 screws shown in Fig.3 to remove the air duct. (Fig. 3 & 4)
3. Remove the 4 screws holding the OE filter. (Fig. 5 & 6)

**NOTE: The four screws securing the OE filter onto the air box will not be used with the K&N® Air Filter.**

4. Align the air box lid over the K&N® filter base and install the included screws using a 3mm allen wrench. (Fig. 7 – 9)
5. Reverse steps 1-4 to complete installation

**THESE INSTRUCTIONS MUST BE FOLLOWED EVERY TIME THE FILTER IS SERVICED, OTHERWISE THE FILTER MAY NOT SEAL, AND DAMAGE TO THE ENGINE COULD RESULT.**
